The renovated building will be dedicated in late April to the memory of Adam Pulling, who went from AYSO player to referee and then Region 211 board member and director of youth referees before his death to cancer in 2004.

Pulling, who was 19 when he died, exemplified the guiding principles of AYSO through his dedication, knowledge, fairness, support of players and their families and love of the game.

The renovation of the concession building is the culmination of seven years of planning and dreaming.
